STEELIX set a solid pace into the stretch then weakened in the drive. IDIDN'TDOANYTHING failed to menace. NOTICE ME NOW showed little. SLAM MY HEART was fractious in the gate, chased early, bid three through the second turn then faltered. SKIP CODE broke through the gate pre start then was no factor.
