HELLO FROM HEAVEN was void of speed for six furlongs, fanned five wide into the stretch then rallied outside late to be up for the place. GHOSTLY THUNDER rushed up into the second turn to challenge, dueled to mid stretch then weakened. CIGAR MAN made a three wide middle move, gained a short lead into the stretch then also weakened in the final furlong. DYNHOCRACY set a slow pace for six furlongs then gave way in the drive. CAJUN CORREDOR was shuffled back into the first turn, made an outside middle move then came up empty. BONNISTAR was no factor. PURSUE A DREAM stopped.
