QUALITY LASS set the early pace off the rail, gained a clear lead into the turn, then dueled with the winner through the stretch and weakened in the late going. XUNLEI well placed and inside, got through inside of rivals into the stretch and flattened out. MY DUE PROCESS vied for the early lead from between rivals, then dropped back and faded in the lane. MAKING AMENDS allowed to settle off the rail in the early going, looped rivals four wide through the turn, came five wide to bid into the stretch, then closed willingly to get up for the place but could not threaten the winner. IT TAKES HEART tracked the early pace off the rail, angled out four wide through the turn to gain position, then flattened out through the drive. TRIPPI'S SECRET vied for the early lead from between rivals, gained a short lead through the turn and weakened in the drive. MUKAMER vied for the early lead inside and was through after a half. VEXOR broke sharply to gain the early lead outside and faltered.

OAKS LILY mid pack and inside, moved up into the second turn, angled out to loop rivals four wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then closed willingly to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. TEN K CAT stalked the early pace three wide, bid on the same path into the stretch, then ran evenly the final furlong and held the show safe. NORMATIVE APPEAL well placed and inside, gained position through the second turn, angled out to bid four wide into the stretch and could not gain the final furlong. GOLDEN HISTORY allowed to settled inside early, passed tiring rivals through the lane. LETS GO DONNA vied for the early lead inside and faded after a half. SHE'S COPACETIC tracked the early pace inside, held position through the second turn and faded in the drive. TIPPIE TAP mid pack and outside, had no stretch rally. GIVEN ENCHANTMENT set the pace three wide and faltered late.

BURN THE MORTGAGE mid pack and off the rail, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, drifted in through the lane, was straightened and closed well to get up for the place in the late going. MOON TRAVELER well placed and inside, moved up through the second turn, angled out to bid into the stretch, then ran evenly in the late going. BIG BLUE NATION stalked the early pace outside, moved up through the second turn to bid three wide into the stretch, then ran evenly through the lane. BIG WEDNESDAY ran evenly, inside. HERE WE GO JOE broke sharply and sprinted to a clear lead, then faltered. MUCHO MAS MACHO improved his position. PATRIOTICANDPROUD was no factor. LAST PRAYER showed little. ALL FOR THE TRIP hopped slightly at the start, trailed the field.
