HOWABOUTRIGHTNOW was through early. COHIBA'S WILDCHILD trailed.

HARBORAGE was unhurried early, fanned four wide out of the second turn then was gaining down the middle of the track late. FIRST MOVEMENT made an inside middle move, angled outside into the stretch but failed to respond when set down. DERBY passed tiring rivals. DR. ELI raced evenly. DIMELO chased for six furlongs then faded. AIR RIDE LOUIS showed little. WORLD BATTLE was hung wide early then stopped after six furlongs.
