

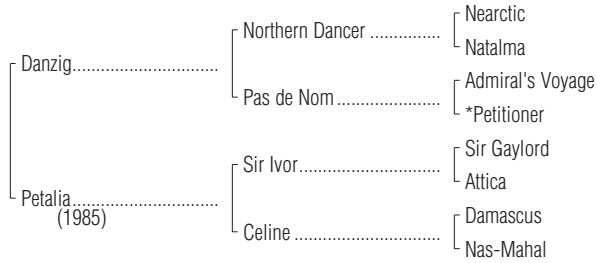

Among the leading broodmare sires in Canada and U.S., sire of dams of 121 stakes winners, including champions Grass Wonder, Believe (JPN), Nishino Flower, Soaring Free, Dancethruthedawn, Festival of Light, and of Caller One, Strategic Choice, Sterling Rose.
