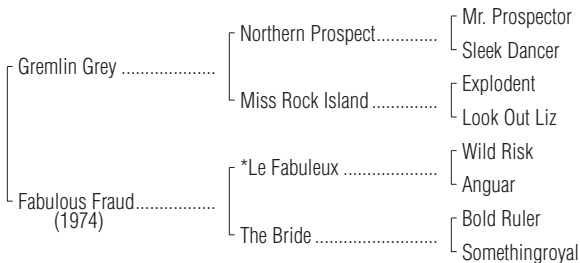


**Fabulous Grey**

His first foals will arrive in 2006. Son of stakes winner Wild Again, among the leading sires, sire of 82 stakes winners, including champions Wilderness Song (15 wins, \$1,482,033, Spinster S. [G1], etc.), Free At Last [G3] (\$411,004), Super I, Blizzard, and of Born Wild [L] (hwt. at 3 in Austria).**
