

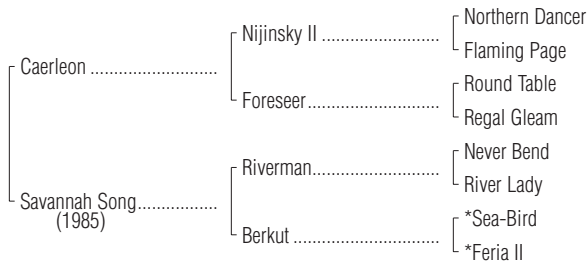

Champion 3-year-old in France, Prix du Jockey Club-French Derby-**G1**, etc. Leading sire 3 times in England and Ireland, sire of 14 crops of racing age, 1026 foals, 851 starters, 120 stakes winners, 13 champions, 608 winners of 1969 races and earning \$13,838,707 in N.A. Sire of dams of 83 stakes winners, including champions Taiki Shuttle, Peace of World, Isca, Pretty Girl, Indiana Girl, and of Mutafaweq, Zipping, Areion, Bardonecchia, Agnetha, Faberger, Kafhar, Sam Holme, Chakra.
