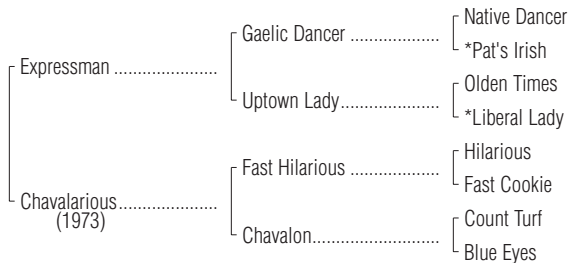

Stakes-placed winner of \$124,500, 2nd National Sprint Championship S.-L, etc. Sire of 15 crops of racing age, 188 foals, 128 starters, 4 stakes winners, 88 winners of 305 races and earning \$2,544,461 in N.A., including Ke Express (5 wins, \$179,448, Rancho Del Charro H. (BM, \$19,635), etc.), Rising Express (\$162,193, Sun Devil S. (TUP, \$15,000), etc.), Poupon Gray (13 wins in 26 starts, \$105,772). Sire of dams of stakes winners Urlacher, McRyanne, Gray Ryder, Bug Hall.

Son of stakes-placed winner Storm Boot, sire of 29 stakes winners, including champion Lillie Boot, and of Bourbon Belle (\$1,152,223, Honorable Miss H. [G3] twice, etc.), Hurricane Bertie (\$940,041, Prioress S. [G2], etc.), Night Patrol [G2].
