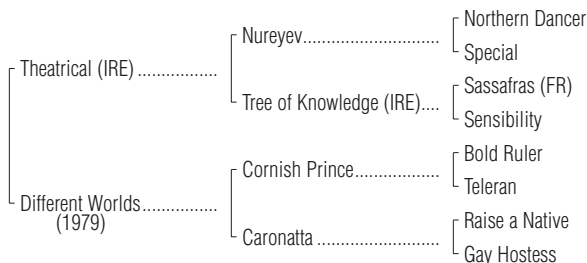

Sire of dams of 15 stakes winners, including champions Numerous Times, Mi Amigo Guelo, and of Dublino, Lyracist, Stylish, Lady of the Future, Walkslikeaduck, Wana, Sharp Performance, Dominique's Joy, Chelsea Manor, Ms Versatility.
