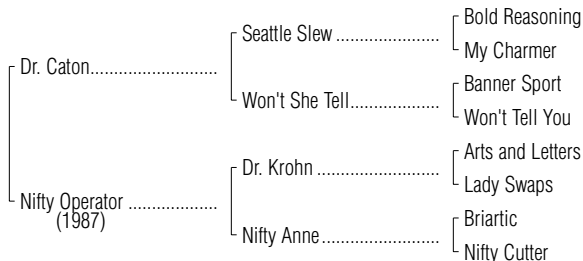

WIND WHIPPER (1996), by Storm Cat--Lady Blessington (FR), by Baillamont. Unplaced in 1 start. His first foals are yearlings of 2003. Son of stakes winner Storm Cat, leading sire twice, sire of 109 stakes winners, including champions Giant's Causeway (Esat Digifone Irish Champion S. [G1], etc.; \$954,000, in N.A./U.S.), Storm Flag Flying (\$988,580, Long John Silver's Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies [G1] (AP, \$520,000), etc.), Aljabr [G1], Hold That Tiger [G1], Silken Cat [L].
