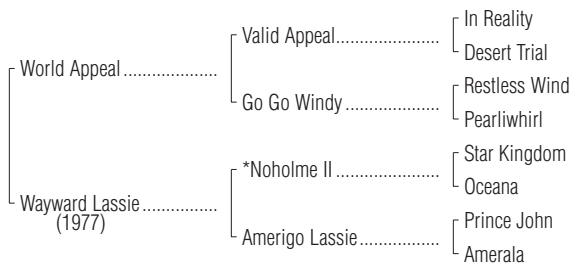


**Appella**

Stakes winner of \$526,739, Pegasus H.-**G2**-etr, etc. Sire of 16 crops of racing age, 362 foals, 292 starters, 13 stakes winners, 216 winners of 876 races and earning \$10,907,036 in N.A., including The Vid (\$952,216, Early Times Dixie S. [**G2**], etc.), Sharp Appeal [**G3**] (11 wins, \$720,036), Jolies Appeal (\$292,298, Bold Ruler S. [**G3**]). Sire of dams of stakes winners Tahkodha Hills, Bold World, Delray Dew, Too too Divine, Dr. Park, Crispy Jet, Special Report, Cagey Move, Potriworld.
