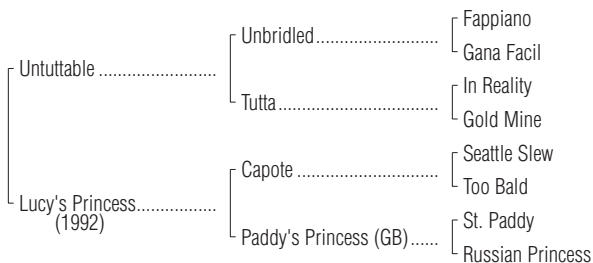

Son of champion Unbridled, among the leading sires, sire of 38 stakes winners, including champions Banshee Breeze (10 wins, \$2,784,798, Coaching Club American Oaks **[G1]**, etc.), Halfbridled (4 wins in 6 starts, \$959,400, Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies **[G1]** (SA, \$520,000), etc.), Anees (\$699,200, Breeders' Cup Juvenile **[G1]**, etc.).
