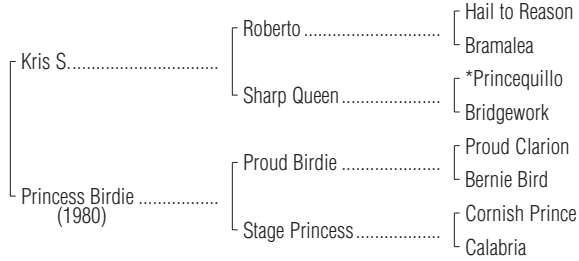


Emerald Starling

Sire of dams of 51 stakes winners, including champions Sweet Catomine, Kristin's Place, Killer Queen, and of Ladies Din, War Chant, Senor Swinger, Balance, Smooth Baritone, Roman Romance, Nonproductiveasset, Royal Place, Ministers Wild Cat, Innit (IRE).

GOLD STAGE (c. by Mr. Prospector). 5 wins to 3, \$292,917, Breeders' Futurity-G2, 2nd Young America S.-G1, Laurel Futurity-G1, Hopeful S.-G1, Flintlock H., 3rd Futurity S.-G1, Sapling S.-G1, Blue Grass S.-G1, etc.

SARAVA (1999), by Wild Again-Rhythm of Life, by Deputy Minister. Classic winner of 3 races at 2 and 3, \$772,620, Belmont S. [G1] (BEL, \$600,000), Sir Barton S. [L] (PIM, \$45,000). His first foals are weanlings of 2006. Son of stakes winner Wild Again, among the leading sires, sire of 82 stakes winners, including champions Wilderness Song (15 wins, \$1,482,033, Spinster S. [G1], etc.), Free At Last (\$411,-004, Summer S. [G3], etc.), Super I., Blizzard, and of Born Wild [L].
