

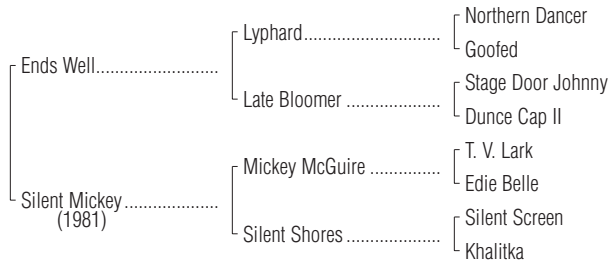

By ENDS WELL (1981). Stakes winner of \$872,093, United Nations H. [G1], etc. Sire of 14 crops of racing age, 280 foals, 233 starters, 14 stakes winners, 173 winners of 679 races and earning \$11,244,086 in N.A., including McKaymackenna [G3] (15 wins, \$581,322), Sherpa Guide (\$391,-919), Rogues Walk (\$386,285, Reeve Schley, Jr. S. [G2], etc.), A in Sociology (\$357,856, National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S. [G2], etc.). Sire of dams of stakes winners Holly Springs, Iron Cop, Dulce de Leche.

SILENT MICKEY, by Mickey McGuire. Winner at 3, \$21,450. Dam of 8 other registered foals, 8 of racing age, 5 to race, 5 winners, including-- Mickey Misterey (g. by Told). 19 wins, 3 to 10, \$67,297. Sir Alf (g. by Told). 8 wins, 2 to 9, \$57,992. Pretty Littleangel (f. by Storm of Angels). Winner at 4 and 5, \$28,337. Ray's Well (f. by Ends Well). Winner at 2, \$12,352.

2nd dam

SILENT SHORES, by Silent Screen. Unraced. Dam of 3 other winners, incl.-- Silent But Loud. 12 wins, 2 to 6, \$91,348. Silent Departure. 3 wins at 3 and 4, \$19,465.

3rd dam

KHALITKA, by *Khaled. Unplaced in 1 start. Sister to **SARACEN SWORD** (Gallinule S., etc.), half-sister to **Thorwaldsen** (in Italy, 2nd Premio Conte Felice Scheibler). Dam of 3 foals, 2 to race, both winners, including-- Little Ridge. 8 wins, 3 to 7, \$31,682.

RACE RECORD: At 2, once 2nd in 1 start; at 3, two wins, 4 times 2nd, once 3rd; at 4, two wins, twice 2nd, once 3rd; at 5, three wins, 3 times 2nd, twice 3rd; at 6, two wins, 6 times 2nd; at 7, one win, twice 2nd, 4 times 3rd; at 8, two wins, 3 times 2nd, 4 times 3rd; at 9, two wins, once 3rd. Totals: 14 wins, 21 times 2nd, 13 times 3rd. Earned \$161,461.

HECKLE (2001), by Hennessy--Bid Me Adieu, by Spectacular Bid. Stakes winner of 3 races at 2 and 3, \$155,862, Tremont S. [G3] (BEL, \$66,120). Half-brother to stakes winners Spectacular Tide, Check Ride. His first foals will arrive in 2007. Son of stakes winner Hennessy, sire of 46 stakes winners, including champions Johannesburg (\$520,000, in N.A., Bessemer Trust Breeders' Cup Juvenile [G1]), Grand Armee (13 wins, Doncaster H. [G1], etc.), Perfect Storm, and of Silver Tree [G2].
