

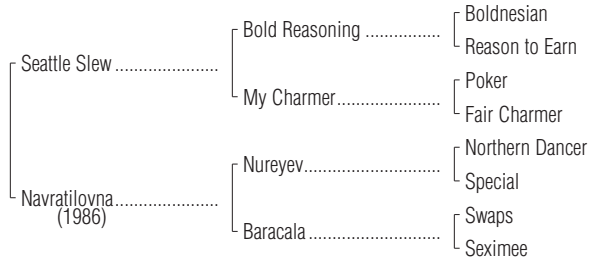

Horse of the year, Triple Crown winner of \$1,208,-726, Kentucky Derby-**G1**, etc. Leading sire, sire of 24 crops of racing age, 1103 foals, 782 starters, 111 stakes winners, 8 champions, 532 winners of 1521 races and earning \$60,725,646 & \$367,576(CAN) in N.A. Leading broodmare sire 3 times in N.A. and United Arab Emirates, sire of dams of 156 stakes winners, 10 champions, including Cigar, Lemon Drop Kid, Hishi Akebono, Escena, Kawakami Princess, Golden Attraction, Mulca.

Son of champion Unbridled, among the leading sires, sire of 47 stakes winners, including champions, Banshee Breeze (\$2,784,798, Coaching Club American Oaks [**G1**], etc.), Half-bridled (4 wins, \$959,400, Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies [**G1**] (SA, \$520,000), etc.), Anees [**G1**] (\$699,200), Smuggler [**G1**] (\$654,352).
