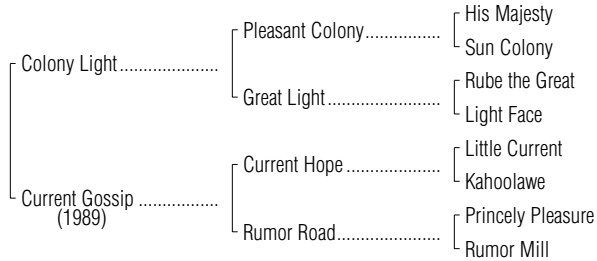

[G1], etc. Sire of 8 crops of racing age, 201 foals, 132 starters, 6 stakes winners, 107 winners of 382 races and earning \$5,851,982/\$952(CAN) in N.A./U.S., including champion Propane, and of Plenty of Light (5 wins, \$510,420, Three Chimneys Spinster S. [G1], etc.), Dakota Light (4 wins to 3, 2003, \$253,720, Three Ring S. [L] (CRC, \$60,000), etc.), Light Dancer (5 wins, \$173,367, Lake George S. [G3], etc.). Sire of dams of winners.

INVISIBLE INK (1998), by Thunder Gulch--Conquistress, by Conquistador Cielo. Stakes-placed winner of 4 races, 2 to 4, \$465,088, 2nd Kentucky Derby [G1], 3rd Florida Derby [G1]. His first foals will arrive in 2004. Son of champion Thunder Gulch, leading sire, sire of 28 stakes winners, including horse of the year Point Given (\$3,968,500, Belmont S. [G1], etc.), and of Spain (\$3,540,542, Breeders' Cup Distaff [G1], etc.), Mystic Lady (10 wins, \$1,170,390, Cotillion H. [G2], etc.).
