

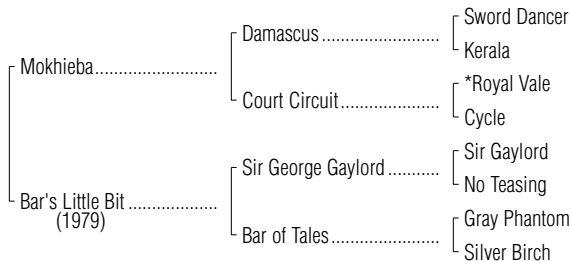

(CT, \$10,676)), Key to the Hill (\$69,146, 2nd Maryland Million Oaks-R (LRL, \$20,000)), Wish It Was (\$21,178, 3rd Tri-State Futurity-R (CT, \$4,077)). Sire of dams of winners.
